Onwards through the upwind sail and it is truly worth it as the Pitons, two extinct volcanoes, appear on the horizon. Tonight we moor between these majestic peaks on St Lucia watching the Caribbean sunset.

From the Pitons we head north to Marigot Bay, a new super yacht marina or Rodney Bay Marina. Both are beautiful and ensure that your last morning onboard is filled with swimming and water sports before you disembark.
