**Day one:** Cookielicious will be ready & awaiting your arrival in Venice, berthed in Marina di Lio Grande. You can spend the afternoon exploring the city or relaxing onboard, getting to know your home for the week.

**Day Two:** Exploring Venice. A day exploring Venice is a must with all the many things to see and do you can either go ashore with your guide book or allow us to arrange a tour for you. Explore San Marco and its 4000 square metres of golden mosaics, sample some renowned seafood risotto for lunch or simply watch the world go by in Piazza San Marco all in the knowledge that your relaxing yacht awaits you.

**Day Three:** On Day three the mooring lines will be slipped long before you awake on the 75 NM journey to Pula in Istria, Croatia. Breakfast & lunch will be served underway whilst Cookielicious cruises its way to Pula for sunset, with just enough time to stretch your legs around the Roman Amphitheatre before dinner & cocktails are served.

**Day Four:** A shorter sail will take us to the island of Losinj where we will visit the main town a popular 3 mile deep natural harbor. With restaurants, shops & markets to explore there will be enough to keep you occupied.

**Day Five:** Winding our way through the sparkling islands of Northern Croatia, anchoring for lunch & a swim in any number of locations we will find our way to Otok Pag. An island famed for its lace and cheese. A quiet night and a medieval town to wander around will be there to greet us.

**Day Six:** Another day of exploring the archipelago and lunching in a secluded anchorage finds us arriving in Zadar. An important regional centre where you will depart from. With us berthing in the marina you may be able to sample some of the history and architecture Croatia is so famed for.

**Day Seven:** After breakfast guests will have time to visit the town before leaving for Zadar airport.
